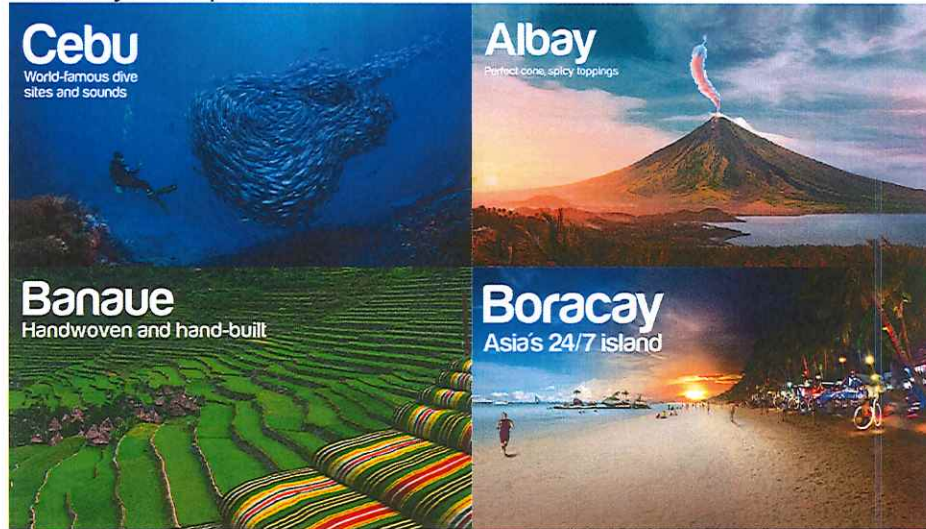

MANILA → CEBU → BOHOL

JULY 9, SUNDAY
Arrive in Manila
Transfer to the hotel for check-in
Rest of the day at leisure or for optional tours
Overnight at the hotel

DAY 1 JULY 9, MONDAY
Breakfast at the hotel
Proceed to Rizal Park for wreath-laying ceremonies with drive-by sighting of Intramuros afterwards
Lunch hosted by Globe Telecom (venue TBA)
Visit to Metropolitan Museum and LST Museum
Dinner hosted by Rita Nerl Events Planners
Overnight at the hotel

DAY 2 JULY 10, TUESDAY
Breakfast at the hotel
Transfer to NAA domestic terminal for flight to Cebu
Depart for Cebu
Arrive in Cebu and transfer to the resort
Check-in and brunch at the resort
Proceed to Cebu Heritage Tour with Lunch
Rediscover Cebu City, the oldest city of the Philippines and sample its rich culture reminiscent of the Spanish and Chinese influence. Drive through the scenic Beverly Hills where the impressive Taoist Temple lords over the whole mountain side, then visit Fort San Pedro, the smallest and oldest tri-bastion fort in the country. Rediscover the Magellan's Cross and the site where the Portuguese explorer, Ferdinand Magellan, planted a cross in 1521, on the very spot where the first Filipinos were baptized. Relive the religious fervor of the early Christian Filipinos at the Basilica Minore del Sto. Niño which houses the image of Sto. Niño, the oldest Spanish religious relic in the Philippines and Cebu's patron saint. Then, experience Cebu's post colonial lifestyle through the splendor of Casa Gorordo Museum, once the residence of the first Filipino Bishop of Cebu (includes Kenneth Coburne Showroom and Profobias Dried Mango Plant)
Return to the hotel in the afternoon
Hosted dinner by Cebu Governor (venue TBA)
Overnight at the hotel

Suray-Suray Tour with Lunch
Assembly at the lobby
0800H Depart hotel for a full day Cultural and Heritage Tour - Suray-Suray Sa Saigbo with lunch

First Stop: CARCAR
KABKABAN Festival is a ritual dance believed to be a way of driving away bad spirits. The term is taken from a kind of grass that is so abundant in the place. Through the inspiration of Val San Diego, the Kabkaban celebration today is given much attention by the Carcaranos and visitors from other places. This annual activity is one of the highlights of Carcar's fiesta in honor of its patroness, St. Catherine of Alexandria. Carcar is known for its locally-made shoes. Bolo making and basket weaving are also some of the prevalent cottage industries among the Carcaranos. Aside from these, Carcaranos are also into wooden furniture manufacturing and antique reproduction.

Second Stop: ARGAO
The Church of Argao possesses one of the remaining fourteen (14) Spanish pipe organs in the Philippines. It is one of the only three remaining organs in the whole province built in the 17th to the 19th century by Spanish pipe organ makers. Argao became a parish in 1703 prompting the construction of a beautiful neo-gothic church structure in 1734 and its completion in 1788. The already renovated and modernized church, San Miguel Archangel Parish, still remains as one of the richly furnished churches in the south today.
The famous Torta de Argao, baked in clay ovens using the traditional ingredients like tuba, is available and can be enjoyed with a hot cup of chocolate or tokolate.
The Cuartel Building, referred to as Apta Building, used to be a military barracks and is now being used as the Hall of Justice. It was rehabilitated through the efforts of Chief Justice Hilario Davide, Jr.
The beaches in Argao - like the Lawit, South, Central and North Beaches - are perfect for swimming, diving, snorkeling and skin-boarding. One can also indulge in the beauty of the sunset or engage in fish-feeding in the ten fish sanctuaries of the different coastal barangays.

Lunch will be served at Dalagute Beach Park.



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Last Stop: SIBONGA
PASTORES DE SIBONGA Pastores de Sibonga is short Christmas play which narrates the story of Christ's nativity as performed in Brgy. Magayong, Sibonga, Cebu, Philippines. The play depicts the shepherd's adoration of the child Jesus.
The Mother Mary Shrine in SIMALTA draws thousands of devotees and first time pilgrims every year bringing their faith and petitions for divine aid and cure. One can write their petitions on a sheet of paper where they can drop it near the encased Marian image. The Marian monks who maintain the shrine have also landscaped the area, which has a mini falls that cascades down a small pool and well-tended gardens.
Return to the resort in the afternoon

Hosted dinner by City Mayor (venue TBA)
Overnight at the resort

DAY 4 JULY 12, THURSDAY
Transfer to Cebu City Pier
Depart for Bohol by fast craft ferry (boat for exclusive use of the group)
Arrive in Tagbilaran
Proceed to Bohol Countryside Tour with Lunch
Home to the famous Chocolate Hills, Bohol is a quaint getaway from the rest of the world. With its white sand beaches, clear blue seas, lush tropical vegetation, and diving spots, Bohol promises to be an unforgettable holiday destination. The tour begins with a drive through the majestic Mahogany Man-Made Forest on your way to the Chocolate Hills, a unique geographical cluster of 1,268 cone-shaped ground formations that look like gigantic chocolate truffles waiting to be eaten. Then, on to the Backleyon Church, one of the oldest stone churches in the Philippines housing religious artifacts dating back to the 15th century. A countryside ride to the Blood Compact Shrine brings you to the site where Datu Sikatuna forged a truce with Conquistador Miguel Lopez de Legazpi and gives you a scenic view of the island. Drive back to Loboc for the Loboc River Cruise where you will be serenaded while having your barbecue lunch.
Proceed to resort for check-in
